



2nd ANNUAL DRAG GAMES
Rules and Regulations Including
The Release of Liability and Claim Waiver Form

- I. The Drag Games is a benefit for charity produced by the Imperial Court of Arizona, Inc.
- II. The Drag Games are open to any person(s) that are not currently doing drag professionally, in pageants, or for charity. These games are geared towards those non-drag members of the community.
- III. The Drag Games are a joint event between the Imperial Court and the businesses and organizations within our community to benefit the charity(s) of choice.
- IV. 1-4 "drag-lete(s)" may be sponsored by any business and/or organization within the realm of the Imperial Court of Arizona, Inc.
- V. The drag-lete(s) will solicit and collect pledges from friends, family, co-workers and the community to benefit the charity(s) of choice.
- VI. The businesses and/or organizations are asked to match those pledges for their drag-lete(s) if they place 1st, 2nd or 3rd in each event.
- VII. This year will consist of 10-12 events that make up the Games.
- VIII. This year will consist of 2 days of events for the Games.
- IX. All drag-letes must sign a Waiver and Release of Claim to participate.
- X. Individual Event(s) Rules and Regulations:
 - A. 50 yard High Heel Dash –
 - All drag-letes will wear high heels to run this race
 - All drag-letes will carry a purse filled with many different items
 - All drag-letes must cross the finish line with heels on and purse on their arm
 - Each drag-lete may be in full drag, partial drag or boy drag. (Keep in mind that a panel of judges will be looking for that drag-lete that has the Spirit of the Games so, dress as you see fit.)
 - B. High Heel Jump Rope –
 - All drag-letes will wear high heels to jump the rope
 - All drag-letes will carry a purse filled with many different items
 - All drag-letes will jump the rope as many times as they can within a 2 minute time limit
 - When a drag-lete misses a jump then their competition in the event is over
 - Judging will consist of the number of jumps made by a drag-lete
 - C. Tit-Sling Toss –
 - All drag-letes will put on a bra
 - Water Balloons will be tossed to the drag-letes
 - The drag-letes have to catch the balloon(s) in their bra without breaking them

- The drag-letes will try to catch as many balloon(s) as possible within a 3 minute timeframe.

D. Tote Throw –

- Each drag-lete will throw the tote as far as possible
- Each tote will be filled with 20lbs of weight
- Each drag-lete will have 3 throws
- The lowest distance will be thrown out and the other 2 added together for the total distance thrown by a drag-lete

E. Roll and Set a Wig –

- Each drag-lete will be provided with the tools to perform this event
- Each drag-lete will have 20 minutes to roll and set as much of the wig as they can
- The scoring will consist of how much of the wig a drag-lete finished and how well they did the event.

F. Pack A Suitcase –

- Each drag-lete will be given a suitcase and a group of items to be packed in that suitcase
- Each drag-lete will have 5 minutes to pack that suitcase with the items
- The scoring will consist on how much the drag-lete packed within the timeframe

G. Make-Up A Mug Marathon –

- Each drag-lete will be given the items to put make-up on a model
- Each drag-lete can furnish their own model or one will be provided
- Each drag-lete will have 25 minutes to make up their model
- The scoring will consist of how much of the model is done and how well the make-up was done within the timeframe

H. 2 Person Wheelbarrow Relay –

- 2 drag-letes will be given a bag of goodies to decorate their wheelbarrow
- The team must decorate the wheelbarrow while wearing pumps
- 1 drag-lete will get into the wheelbarrow while the other pushes them in the first 50 yards
- The drag-letes will then switch places and the 2nd drag-lete will push the 2nd 50 yards
